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## FOREWORD

This listing describes a segment of the society of scientific people who are making significant contributions to the advancement of space science and technology; thus, the title is Space Scientists and Engineers: Selected Biographical and Bibliographical Listing, 1957-1961.

Sponsorship may be traced to the Office of United Nations Conference, National Aeronautics and Space Administration, organized during 1960 for the purpose of providing support for an international conference on the peaceful uses of outer space.

Dr. Douglas L. Worf, Assistant Director for Technical Papers Program, supervised the compilation of biographical and bibliographical information on approximately 1,000 authors of technical papers to be considered for presentation at a proposed United Nations conference. These papers included those submitted by scientists of NASA, which are here designated "Proposed Paper." His deputy was Mr. Manley J. Hood, Technical Assistant to the Director, Ames Research Center. Research facilities were provided by the Aeronautics Section, Science and Technology Division, Library of Congress.

Although plans for the proposed United Nations sponsorship of the conference did not materialize, the compilation by the Technical Papers Program is published as this listing to insure its availability.
